Selected data is from published 2000 Census reports and apply to the year 2000 unless otherwise indicated. Numbers presented may vary somewhat from those given elsewhere due to either different source material or minor technical adjustments to census figures.

Five municipalities in the metro Milwaukee area have land area in multiple counties (the cities of Hartford and Milwaukee and the villages of Bayside, Mukwonago and Newburg). In each of these cases, numbers given are aggregates over all county locations. Municipalities located in multiple counties are listed under the respective county in which the largest portion of their population resides.
