

## Cost of Living Index

### Metro Milwaukee Cost of Living

Metro Milwaukee's Cost of Living Index for 2022's third quarter was 100.1, ranking at the U.S. city average of 100. Costs for grocery, housing, transportation, and miscellaneous goods & services ranked less than average. Conversely, costs associated with utilities and health care ranked above average.

The Cost of Living Index measures differences between areas in the costs of consumer goods and services, excluding taxes and nonconsumer expenditures, for a midmanagement standard of living. It is based on 57 items, for which prices are collected quarterly by each participating urban area. Small differences should not be interpreted as showing any measurable difference.
